The Christmas season is a time of joy and celebration, but it's important to remember that **Jesus is the real reason for the holiday**, and the message of love, joy and hope he brought.


Love: Jesus came to give us love.

Hope: Jesus is always with us.


Joy: Jesus comforts and encourages us.

Merissa Esposito

Meet Merissa Esposito, a dedicated member of Latrobe BPW for the past year. In that time, Merissa has quickly become an integral part of the membership as a guest speaker sharing her expertise and educating others about fraud prevention. She recently joined the board of directors as Finance Chair.

For Merissa, the best part of BPW has been the camaraderie and sisterhood she's experienced. "It's a wonderful group," she says, "where you truly feel that everyone cares about you and wants to see you succeed." Since joining, she has had the opportunity to meet some of the most amazing people she's ever known, gaining invaluable insights from guest speakers and fellow members. One of the highlights of her BPW journey so far has been the opportunity to speak about fraud prevention at a BPW meeting. "Educating the public on something I dedicate my life to is something that means a lot to me," she shares. "Being able to do it in front of a group of women who genuinely care is even better."

Merissa's advice to new members is simple but powerful: "Don't be afraid to put yourself out there and network at our meetings." She encourages members, whether introverted or extroverted, to embrace the warmth and support of the BPW community. "You'll be met with open arms no matter what," she says. "And don't hesitate to step out of your comfort zone by joining different committees." Merissa herself has gained valuable experience by serving as both the finance auditor and the finance chair, roles that have not only enhanced her resume but also expanded her financial expertise.

Currently, Merissa works as an anti-money laundering associate for Navy Federal Credit Union, a position she's excited to have recently started. She is passionate about her field, particularly fraud prevention and anti-money laundering investigations. "What I love most is that in some indirect way, I could be helping to change somebody's life in a positive way," she explains. Through her work, Merissa not only learns how to protect herself, family, and friends from fraud but also plays a crucial role in uncovering larger issues such as trafficking or terrorism. "The information I uncover could ultimately save lives," she says, reflecting on the broader impact of her work.

Outside of work, Merissa is a proud mom to two amazing kids, and spending time with them is one of her favorite ways to relax. But her creativity doesn't stop at parenting—she also enjoys hosting paint parties as a side job. "I work with a company in White Oak, but I also run my own traveling paint company out of Westmoreland County," she says. These paint parties are a fun and creative outlet that allows her to share her artistic skills with others.

Merissa's decision to join BPW came at a time when she was new to Latrobe and wanted to become more involved in the community. She also had a small business at the time, creating hand-painted press-on nails, and a fellow BPW member invited her to a meeting. The opportunity to network with other business owners was exactly what she was looking for. "It felt like the perfect way to connect with like-minded women," she says.

Many people might be surprised to learn that Merissa loves to sing. "I sing at every church opportunity or public event where I'm able to perform in front of a crowd," she shares. Her love for singing is a testament to her willingness to put herself out there and share her talents with others—just like she does in her professional and community life.

Merissa is not just focused on her current career in anti-money laundering; she's also working towards a legal degree to become a white-collar crime prosecutor. "I want to be a voice for victims of fraud and other financial crimes," she says. In addition to her studies, she's pursuing certifications in anti-money laundering and fraud, aiming to become a credentialed advocate for the community. Her goal is to continue educating the public on how to stay safe from financial crimes.




